

Friendship Sampler Row 2



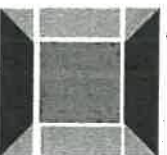
Spool Block

- From 1st dark cut: 1 – 3 ½" square
- From 2nd dark cut: 2 – 2" x 6 ½"
- From cream cut: 4 – 2" squares and 2 – 2" x 3 ½" cream

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the cream 2" squares. Lay one square on each end of the 2" x 6 ½" second dark fabric. Sew on the drawn lines, noting angles, cut away excess and press.



Sew together block per diagram. Should measure 6 ½" square.



Hole in the Barn

- From 1st dark cut: 4 – 1 ½" x 2 ½"
- From 2nd dark cut: 2 – 2 7/8" squares
- From cream cut: 2 – 2 7/8" squares, 4 – 1 ½" x 2 ½" and 1 – 2 ½" square

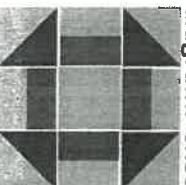
Sew together 4 sets of 1 ½" x 2 ½" first dark and cream. These should now measure 2 ½" square.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the cream 2 7/8" squares. Lay right sides together with the 2nd darks 2 7/8" squares. Sew ¼" away from the drawn line. Do this on both sides of line. Cut apart on the line, and press. You will now have 4 – 2 ½" squares. Trim blocks as needed.



Sew together block per diagram. Should measure 6 ½" square.



Ribbon Star

- From 1st dark cut: 8 – 2" x 3 ½"
- From 2nd dark cut: 4 – 2" squares
- From cream cut: 12 – 2" squares

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all cream and 2nd dark squares.
Make 4 flying geese units, using 4 – 2" x 3 ½" of 1st dark and 8 – 2" cream squares.

Lay one square right sides together on the right end of the 2" x 3 1/2". Align raw edges, sew on the line, cut away excess and press. Lay another square on the left end, right sides together. Again align raw edges, sew cut and press.

You will now have 4 flying geese units measuring 2" x 3 1/2"



Make 4 angle blocks using all remaining cuts.

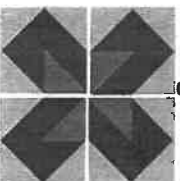
Lay a cream on the right end of the 2" x 3 1/2" 1st dark and a 2" square of 2nd dark on the left end. Note direction of sew lines. Align raw edges, sew cut and press. Should now measure 2" x 3 1/2".



Sew a flying geese unit to the top of a angle block. See diagram. Should measure 3 1/2" square.



Then sew the 4 units together to form 6 1/2" block



Wool Applique

From applique base light cut 3 – 4" x 7"

Trace shapes onto paper side of freezer paper. Fuse heat n bond lite to the wrong side of all wools. Cut freezer paper shapes apart, do not cut on the lines but around the shapes. Iron freezer paper, shiny side down to the right side of your wools. Cut applique shapes out on the line. Pull away the freezer paper and the heat n bond lite paper. This method avoids having to reverse any shapes.

Follow diagram and position all applique shapes in the center of your base fabric.

Then pin in place with applique pins.

Stitch around the shapes using valdani pearl cottons and a button hole stitch.

For stitched stems use a back stitch. For flowers with heavier stems use a chain stitch or Hungarian braided chain stitch. I have a video on my Facebook page ([facebook.com/cottagerosequilt/](https://www.facebook.com/cottagerosequilt/)) for the Hungarian braided chain stitch. Use French knots in center of some flowers for detail.

When done stitching trim your base to 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Sashing

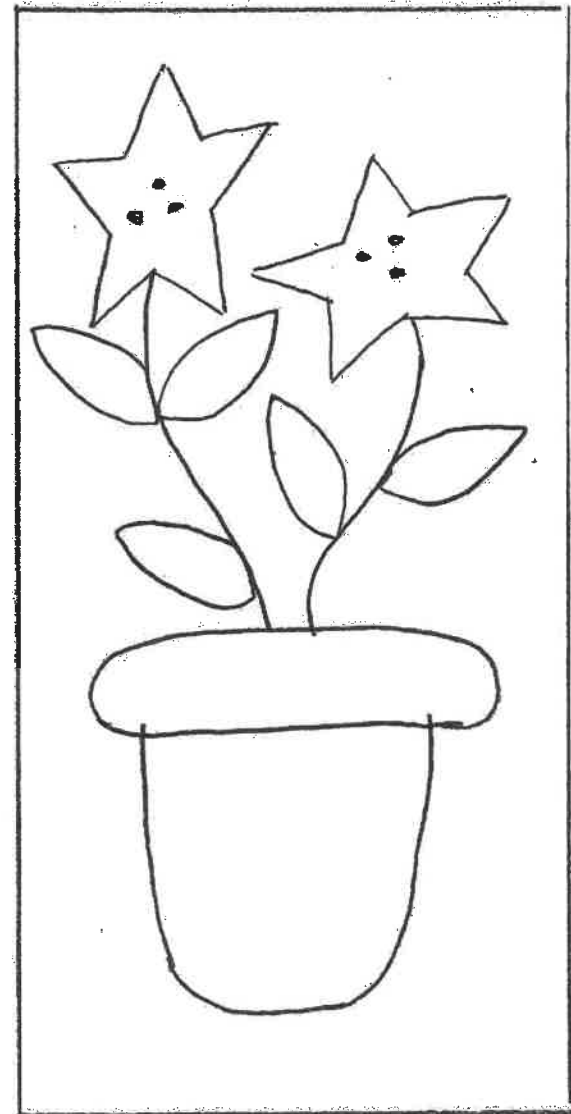
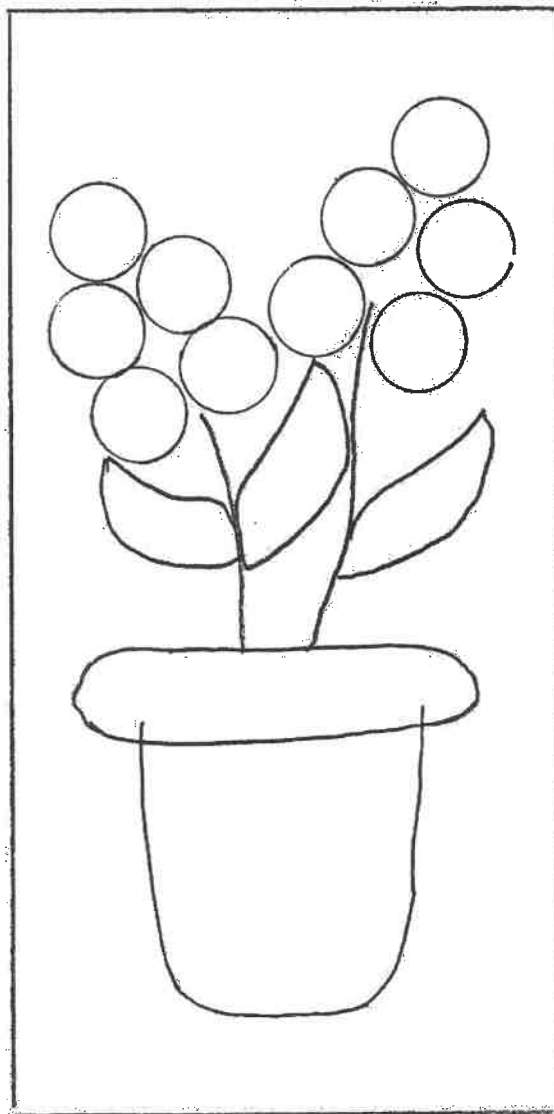
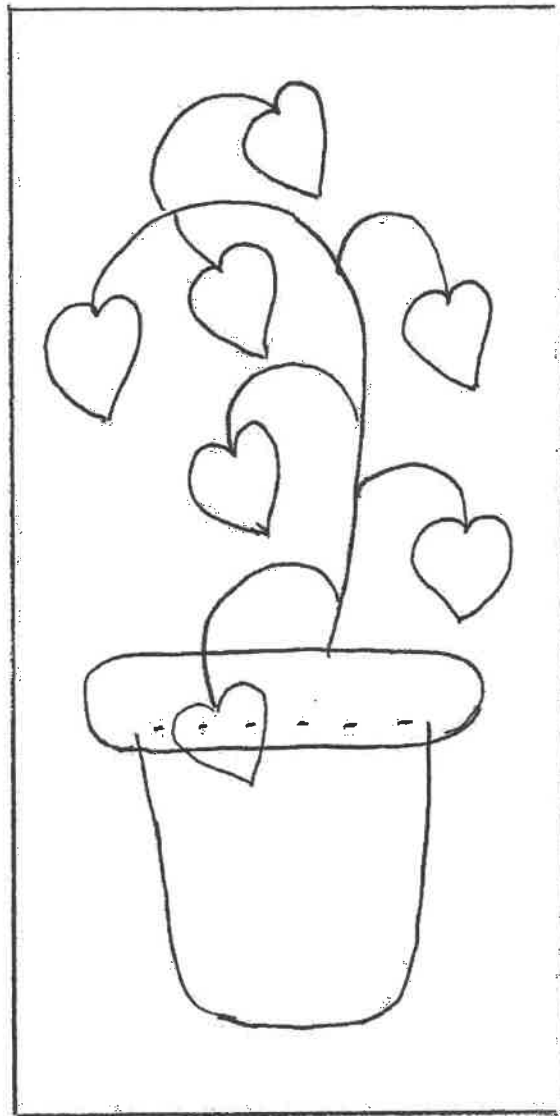
If you have not already cut sashing as described in Row 1 you will need to cut sashing fabric: 5 - 1" x 6 1/2". If already cut grab 5 – 1" x 6 1/2" pieces and put row 2 together.

Sew together your row flower, sashing, pieced block, sashing, flower, sashing, pieced block, sashing, flower, sashing, pieced block.
