

Friendship Sampler Row Three



Please refer to patterns from previous rows for basic instructions.

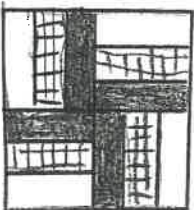
Pieced Block #1:

Cutting: From each of three fabrics (□ light), (▨ medium), and (■ dark) cut (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Sew three rectangles together to make four identical sections as shown. Press seams all one direction.



Make four

Sew sections together as shown. Square up to $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Pieced Block #2:

Cutting: □ Light-Cut (2) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

▨ Medium-Cut (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

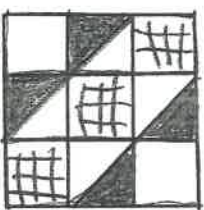
■ Dark-Cut (2) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of the two light $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Pin them, right sides together, to the two dark $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{8}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press units open. You will have four light/dark half-square-triangle units. Square up to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four

Sew the half-square-triangle units and the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together as shown.



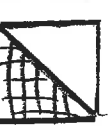
Pieced Block #3:

Cutting: □ Light-Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

▨ Medium-Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

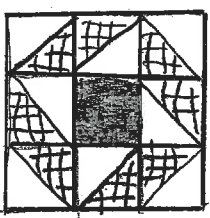
■ Dark-Cut (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of the four light squares. Pin them, right sides together, to the four medium squares. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{8}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press units open. You will have eight light/medium half-square-triangle units. Square up to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make eight

Sew units together as shown with the dark square in the center. Square up to $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



The Appliqued Blocks:

The Sashing:

Use five of the vertical sashing strips (cut as instructed for the first row) to sew this row together. Use the picture as your guide.
