

## Friendship Sampler

### Row 4

by "the cottage rose" Deb Eggers

#### 4 Patch Corner Star

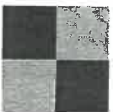


From 1<sup>st</sup> dark cut: 8 – 1 ½" squares

From 2<sup>nd</sup> dark cut: 2 – 2 7/8" squares and 1 – 2 ½" square

From cream cut: 2 – 2 7/8" squares and 8 – 1 ½" squares

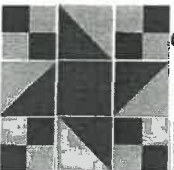
Make 4 – four patch blocks using the 1 ½" squares of 1<sup>st</sup> dark and the cream.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the cream 2 7/8" squares. Lay right sides together with the 2<sup>nd</sup> darks 2 7/8" squares. Sew ¼" away from the drawn line. Do this on both sides of line. Cut apart on the line, and press. You will now have 4 – 2 ½" squares. Trim blocks as needed.



Put block together per diagram. Should measure 6 ½" square



#### Quarter Square Triangle Star

From 1<sup>st</sup> dark cut: 2 – 3 ¼" squares

From 2<sup>nd</sup> dark cut: 2 – 3 ¼" squares

From cream cut: 5 – 2 ½" squares

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3 ¼" 1<sup>st</sup> dark. Lay right sides together with the 3 ¼" square of 2<sup>nd</sup> dark.

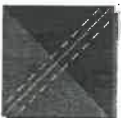
Sew ¼" on both sides of drawn line.



Cut apart on line.

Press these half square triangle units open and lay the right sides together, nesting seam line and making sure that the 1<sup>st</sup> dark section is on top of a 2<sup>nd</sup> dark section. Draw a diagonal line going opposite direction of seam. Follow diagram as needed. *Note: all row edges will align, diagram is done so that it shows how colors and seam line match.*

Again sew ¼" on both sides of drawn line. Cut apart on line and press open.



You should now have 4 quarter square triangle units. Square them up as needed to 2 ½" square. Put square together per diagram. Should measure 6 ½" square.



### Spinning Star

From 1<sup>st</sup> dark cut: 2 – 2" x 3 ½"

From 2<sup>nd</sup> dark cut: 2 – 2" x 3 ½"

From cream cut: 4 – 2" x 3 ½" and 8 – 2" squares

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 2" cream squares.

Lay one square on each end of the 1<sup>st</sup> dark. Note angle of sew line. Sew on lines, cut away excess and press. Make 2



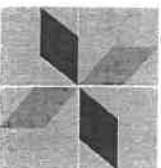
Repeat this process with the 2<sup>nd</sup> dark and remaining 2" cream squares. Make 2.



Sew a 2" x 3 ½" to top of each angle block. These should measure 3 ½" square.



Sew block together per diagram. Should measure 6 ½" square.



### Wool Applique

From applique base light cut 3 – 4" x 7"

Trace shapes onto paper side of freezer paper. Fuse heat n bond lite to the wrong side of all wools. Cut freezer paper shapes apart, do not cut on the lines but around the shapes. Iron freezer paper, shiny side down to the right side of your wools. Cut applique shapes out on the line. Pull away the freezer paper and the heat n bond lite paper. This method avoids having to reverse any shapes.

Follow diagram and position all applique shapes in the center of your base fabric.

Then pin in place with applique pins.

Stitch around the shapes using Valdani pearl cottons and a button hole stitch.

For stitched stems use a back stitch. For flowers with heavier stems use a chain stitch or Hungarian braided chain stitch. I have a video on my Facebook page ([facebook.com/cottageosequity/](https://www.facebook.com/cottageosequity/)) for the Hungarian braided chain stitch. Use French knots in center of some flowers for detail.

When done stitching trim your base to 3 ½" x 6 ½"

### Sashing

If not already cut, you will need to cut sashing fabric: 5 - 1" x 6 ½"

Sew together your row flower, sashing, pieced block, sashing, flower, sashing, pieced block, sashing, flower, sashing, pieced block.
